

Reproductive Justice Smartfund

Goodnation's Reproductive Justice Smartfund is an effective way to fund vetted nonprofits offering immediate, medium- and long-term support of reproductive rights and safe abortion access with just one gift. The vetted nonprofits below provide financial, logistical and emotional support; offer education and raise awareness; and advocate for improved policies. The fund is designed to help donors directly support those states and communities that are at particular high risk due to state-level bans, including southern states and historically excluded communities.

Abortion bans only ban safe abortions. Regardless of whether abortion is legal or not, people still require and regularly access abortion services. According to the Guttmacher Institute, the abortion rate is 37 per 1,000 people in countries that prohibit abortion altogether or allow it only in instances to save a woman's life, and 34 per 1,000 people in countries that broadly allow for abortion, a difference that is not statistically significant. *Amnesty International*

Direct Service: 50%



[Lilith Fund](#) supports the right of all Texans to make their own reproductive choices, regardless of income. They provide financial assistance and emotional support while building community spaces for people who need abortions in Texas—unapologetically, with compassion and conviction.



[ARC Southeast](#) provides funding and logistical support to ensure Southerners receive safe and compassionate reproductive care including abortion services. Through education and leadership development, they build power in communities of color to abolish stigma and restore dignity and justice.



[Plan C](#) transforms access to abortion in the US by normalizing the self-directed option of abortion pills by mail. They do this through research, education, collaborative relationships, destigmatization and advocacy.

Sector Change: 30%



[Physicians for Reproductive Health](#) organizes, mobilizes, and amplifies the voices of medical providers to advance sexual and reproductive health, rights and justice. Their programs combine education, advocacy, and strategic communications to ensure access to abortion care and equitable, comprehensive health care.



[National Network of Abortion Funds](#) builds power with members to remove financial and logistical barriers to abortion access by centering people who have abortions and organizing at the intersections of racial, economic, and reproductive justice.
